



Peter Bancroft Prize for Research Work

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. The Peter Bancroft Prize for Research Work is awarded for Doctor of Philosophy (Medicine) graduate(s) whose thesis has been passed by all examiners without requiring any emendations, amendments or corrections.
- b. This Prize is funded by a donation from Lousie Bancroft to the Peter Bancroft Prize gift.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Students must pass their thesis examination by all examiners without the requirement for any emendations, amendments or corrections.
- b. Students must have not exceeded 3.5 EFTSL at the time of thesis submission.
- c. Students must have awarded the Doctor of Philosophy (Medicine) degree within the calendar year of the award*.

* The Prize will be awarded on results ending 31 December each year to a graduate or graduates awarded the degree within the preceding 12 months.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded by the Executive Dean, Faculty of Medicine and Health on the recommendation of the Associate Dean (Research Education), Faculty of Medicine and Health.

4. Value

- a. The value of the Prize will be determined by the Associate Dean (Research Education), Faculty of Medicine and Health.
- b. The Prize value will be paid as a one-off payment.
- c. No other amount is payable.
- d. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing Eligibility

- a. None apply.

6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.
